This month I enjoyed packing "Pirate Power Packs" with the 4UCC4Christ volunteers. "Pirate Power Packs" are packages of food items distributed by the Garaway Local School District to children whose families need a helping hand.



This program was started right here in Baltic, and now serves schools all across the district. I was kindly invited to help out with packing at the United Church of Christ here in Baltic, with our local volunteer group "4UCC4Christ" under the direction of Janice Schilling. 4UCC4Christ is a partnership between four local UCC congregations, though volunteers come from a number of different denominations and towns.

Janice was kind enough to show me around the facilities that the church provides for storage of the food and goods between packing days, while she explained how the system works.

Much of the food comes from the Canton Akron Food Bank. It is purchased, at a low cost, and shipping of the food is provided through the generosity of a facility in Dover which allows the use of their shipping dock.

\*Due to the transfer of the Water and Sewer plants to Tuscarawas County, no hunting or trapping permits will be issued by the village for those lands any longer. The County will now be responsible for that land.
